FOOD PREPARED AND SERVED FOR STUDENTS

From January 2023



This document sets out the policy of Soroti School of Business for how it will prepare and serve food to students during their studies.

- 1. Dry tea without sugar is provided at 10.30am. Students are free to provide their own sugar and their own accompaniment or 'escort'.
- 2. Students are not allowed to be in or around the vicinity of the kitchen at any time of the day or evening. Any student found inside the kitchen or its immediate vicinity who has no clear reason to be there will face disciplinary action from the school. Students who are persistently found in the school kitchen will face being excluded from the school altogether.
- 3. Morning tea, lunch and supper will only be served to students who have paid 100% of their hostel fees or Day Students who have paid 100% of their meal fees, which is 60,000 Ush per semester.
- 4. Lunch will be served between 1pm and 2pm. No lunch will be served to students outside of this time. Supper will be served to students between 6pm and 7pm. No supper will be served to students outside of this time. Any student coming outside of these hours should not expect to be served lunch or supper and should not request that it be served to them.
- 5. Any student found harassing staff at the kitchen, demanding to be served tea or food outside of the prescribed hours, or directly from the kitchen, or who demand that additional food is added to their plates at the kitchen, will be reported to the school administration.
- 6. The Administration will consult with students from time to time about food provided to them while at school.
