

STUDENT HEALTH AND WELL-BEING SUPPORT

From March 2020



This document sets out the policy of Soroti School of Business for how it will support students who fall sick during the time they are studying at the school. It applies from March 2020.

1. The school does not provide financial support to students who fall ill during their time of studying at Soroti School of Business. However, it is the duty of students to advise the administration of the school if they are experiencing illness or if they are aware that another student at school is sick.
2. All female students staying a hostel managed by the school will be tested by a medical professional for pregnancy when they report to school. Additional tests for pregnancy will be conducted without notice and all female students must cooperate with this testing. Any female student refusing to be tested for pregnancy will not be admitted at any hostels managed by the school.
3. All students staying a hostel managed by the school will be tested for malaria when they report to school. Additional testing for malaria can be conducted without notice and all students must cooperate with this testing. Any student refusing to be tested for malaria will not be admitted to any hostels managed by the school.
4. All students must make their own provision for getting medical treatment if they fall sick. Below is a form that each student is required to complete and return to the school when they report, advising the school of who should be contacted if they suffer from illness that needs a test or treatment.
5. The school will offer care for the student who is undergoing treatment for malaria or any other short-term medical problem. If, however, the administration feels that it is best for the student to go home to complete their treatment then the student must comply with this ruling and go home. Transport for this journey will be requested from the individual(s) names on the form below.
6. The school administration is willing to hold funds on behalf of an individual student so that the funds can be used immediately for testing and treatment. Once these funds have been used up, the information provided by the student on the form below will be used to access funding for further treatment and support.
7. This policy only applies to students who wish to reside in a hostel managed by the school. Day students should make their own provision for paying for tests and treatment.
